The City of Holland Election Commission met at 5:45 PM in Council Chambers in City Hall, 270 River Ave.

1. The Commission approved minutes from the September 17, 2025 Elections Commission Meeting, moved by Bocks, support from Katerberg and a vote of all in favor.
2. Upon motion by Mayor Bocks, seconded by Clerk Katerberg and vote of all in favor adopted the following resolution for conducting the May 5, 2026 election:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Justin Roebuck and/or Katelyn Bard and/or Brenda Katerberg and/or Aaron Nier are hereby designated as the authorized assistants of this Election Commission responsible for scheduling of the required public accuracy test and the final inspection on the voting devices to be used at this election, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Election Commission of the City of Holland, Michigan, hereby provides that absent voter ballots for this election shall be counted by the Ottawa and Allegan Absentee Ballot Counting Boards at City Hall, City of Holland, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Election Commission of the City of Holland, Michigan, hereby appoints persons on the list attached as **Exhibit A** as election inspectors for said election in the regular precincts and in the absent voter counting board, with the first named person in each precinct to be the chairperson for that precinct, and authorizes the City Clerk and/or Elections Coordinator of the City of Holland to fill vacancies, if any, as provided by law, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Election Commission of the City of Holland, Michigan, hereby appoints persons on the list attached as **Exhibit B** as receiving board members to inspect the material from each precinct and to reseal and make it secure with the City Clerk and/or Elections Coordinator of the City of Holland.
