## Noburo "Peanuts" Fukuda Statue plaque & upcoming unveiling event

The Commissioners reviewed the draft text prepared by staff for the Noburo "Peanuts" Fukuda statue plaque. The Commission agreed the text was well written and did not recommend any changes. Staff also notified the Commissioners of the upcoming unveiling of the statue in June and advised that invitations will be sent once all event details have been finalized.

## Art in City Hall

Commissioner Fleming recommended expanding the City Hall art program. Staff and commissioners discussed potential approaches to support this expansion. Staff agreed to review best practices for displaying artwork in public spaces, noting that the original exhibit was limited due to the availability of only one locked display case. Staff will evaluate options for securely exhibiting artwork in publicly accessible areas.

## Arts and Culture Commission recruitment and term limits

Commissioners and staff discussed upcoming term expirations for positions ending June 30, 2026. It was noted that Commissioners whose terms are expiring and who wish to continue serving will need to reapply. The Commission also discussed strategies for promoting the vacant positions to encourage broader community awareness and participation.
