BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Town of Redcliff, in partnership with Cypress County and the City of Medicine Hat, is currently participating in a Regional Emergency Management Plan (REMP) review and modernization project being facilitated by Transitional Solutions Inc. (TSI).

The REMP serves as the overarching governance framework that guides how the three municipalities collectively approach emergency management, including disaster mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery activities. The project is being undertaken in two phases, with Phase One focused on establishing a clear and sustainable regional governance model for emergency management.

As part of this process, TSI conducted surveys and stakeholder engagement with elected officials, Chief Administrative Officers, Directors of Emergency Management (DEMs), and Deputy Directors of Emergency Management (DDEMs) from each participating municipality. The information gathered has been used to identify areas of alignment, key themes, and potential differences in expectations regarding regional emergency management governance.

The purpose of the Council workshop is to provide elected officials with an opportunity to discuss regional emergency management governance, review potential governance models, and provide direction regarding the desired level of collaboration between the three municipalities. Feedback received during the workshop will assist in determining the preferred governance approach and will guide the development of the updated Regional Emergency Management Plan in Phase Two of the project.

Administration has invited representatives from Transitional Solutions Inc. to provide a delegation and facilitate discussion with Council regarding the project and potential governance options.
