**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

As you know, our election precincts are staffed by City Election Inspectors. The appointment letters for these inspectors will be mailed immediately following their appointments. We would like the Commission to approve the entire list of election inspectors, and we would also like to appoint the City Clerk's Staff as the receiving board inspectors for purposes of reviewing materials at the end of the night.

The motion I recommended below also authorizes the City Clerk to make emergency appointments of election inspectors if needed, for example, if we had a last minute need for replacement election inspectors. Additionally it will allow the City Clerk to fill any remaining vacant spots, that we are currently working on.

As a point of information to the Commission, the inspectors report to work on election day as follows: Precinct Chairs and Vice Chairs report at 5:15 a.m., General Inspectors report to work at 5:45 a.m., and the Absent Voter Counting Board all report at 7:00 a.m. Early Voting Precinct Chairs; Vice Chairs and General Inspectors report to work at 8:00 am.

**Roads and Highways Maintenance and Repair Millage Renewal Proposal**

For the sole purpose of funding general operating expenses to be incurred in maintenance and repair of roads and highways within the County of Leelanau, at the same millage level previously approved by the voters every two years since 1986, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Leelanau, Michigan, be renewed at 0.5000 mill (\$0.5000 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of two (2) years (2026-2027) inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$2,104,175 for road and highway maintenance and repair general operating expenses in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. In accordance with State law, the millage will be disbursed to the Leelanau County Road Commission, and the Villages of Empire, Northport, and Suttons Bay.

For the sole purpose of continuing an operating millage for the funding of Senior Citizen Services within Leelanau County, at the same millage level previously approved by the voters in 2024, shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within the County of Leelanau imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be renewed at 0.3145 of one (1) mill, and shall the previously authorized reduced millage of 0.0055 of one (1) mill be restored, for a return to the previously voted total limitation increase of up to 0.3200 mill (\$0.32 per \$1,000 of Taxable Value) for a period of four (4) years, 2026 through 2029, inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$1,346,672.00 for the county-wide Senior Citizen Services in the first calendar year of the levy based on taxable value. As required by State law, a portion of the millage may be captured by the Leelanau County Brownfield Authority.
