### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS TO CONSIDER PRESERVATION DETERMINATIONS AND WAIVERS FOR BUILDINGS

**Public Hearings to be held by the Historical Commission to begin at 7:00 p.m. on  
Monday, July 13, 2026, as an online virtual meeting on Zoom.**

In accordance with Article 46C, Historic Preservation Demolition Review, of the Town of Wellesley Town Bylaws, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold public hearings to consider whether or not a building used as a dwelling, constructed on or prior to December 31, 1949, and intended to be demolished, should be Preferably Preserved at the following locations:

- 22 Standish Road
- 53 Hunnewell Street

Furthermore, the Wellesley Historical Commission will hold a public hearing to consider a reduction of the Delay Period imposed by the Commission on the demolition of the building used as a dwelling at the following locations:

- 14 Heckle Street
